ORDINARY MEETING - 14TH JULY, 1992.

Aldermen :

1. HAWKESBURY RIVER - PROMOTIONAL STRATEGY GR60/11

Recently I met with representatives of tourism operators on the Hawkesbury River, members of Tourism Hawkesbury and Council Officers, to discuss promotional strategies proposed to counter the adverse publicity and the effect of this on the district resultant from reports on the status of the Hawkesbury River system.

The principal purpose of this meeting was to discuss ways in which we could counter the negative impact this publicity has had on the area, particularly in relation to visitation and the general public's perception of the river and area generally.

As a consequence of these meetings a number of promotional concepts have developed and investigations have taken place as to suitable avenues available for the implementation of this information. An investigation has been made of general media areas including television and radio. There would appear to be a number of opportunities in this regard and it is proposed that appropriate press releases be distributed to the major radio stations and all TV networks with a view to obtaining some prime time exposure promoting the river and environs in a positive fashion.

Further, it is proposed to co-ordinate and collate information and reports on works and studies being undertaken by various groups and associations including Hornsby Council, Sydney University, the Water Board, Maritime Services Board, the Fisheries Department and the Environmental Protection Authority. It is further proposed to liaise with the respective Presidents/Mayors from neighbouring councils with a view to advising them of these proposals and seeking their support as well as notifying WSROC generally of the situation.

Aldermen, I commend these actions to you on the basis of proceeding as outlined herein with a view to providing positive exposure of the area which, hopefully, will have tangible benefit to the local community and economy.

IT IS RECOMMENDED that the information be received and the proposed actions be endorsed.

Inspected property 2443 Lawrence Road, Blasland's Ridge, as a
result of a request by Alderman C Paine regarding possible clearing
of trees and burning of tree debris, 3rd July 1992.

There was evidence of previous tree removal which from
appearances had been undertaken some time earlier had
been partially windrowed and was being burnt. There was
also evidence of further trees which from appearances had
been either storm damaged or pushed down by machine
although no machine was observed on site at time of inspection.

The owner Mr Dzymanowicz was spoken to regarding
tree removal and replied that apart from general light
removal of box thorn & underscamb he had not undertaken
any tree removal, he had undertaken work using a
tractor to further heap or windrow material previously cut
and had obtained permission to burn from the EPA Deputy.

Mr Dzymanowicz has been advised of Councils Tree Preservation
Order & for the need to observe the requirements of that order
prior to the undertaking of any intended works.

Recommended that no further action is required.
