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ITEM: 18 WEBBS CREEK FERRY**FILE NUMBER:** GT240/007 PT02/ENG

REPORT:

For a considerable time tourist buses have been experiencing difficulty in accessing the Webb's Creek Ferry due to a combination of the configuration of the approach ramps and also the minimal height distance provided in the coaches.

Representations were made by the Wisemans Ferry and District Chamber of Commerce to have alterations undertaken to the ferry flaps to facilitate the use by tourist coaches however this action while improving the situation marginally has not been successful. Mr Bill McNamara, the proprietor of Del Rio Resort at Webbs Creeks has developed a proposal to alter the grade on the approach ramps to enable access by tourist coaches. He has discussed the matter with the Roads and Traffic Authority and it has been indicated to him that they will support the proposal and provide funds to undertake the works subject to Councils support of the proposal also.

Mr McNamara has also offered to fund the engineering design of the proposal.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the proposal developed by Mr McNamara to alter the grades on the approach ramps to Webbs Creek Ferry be supported.

ITEM: 19 **EXTEND IRRIGATION PIPELINE****FILE NUMBER:** 1908/R PT03, P1908/1985 PT01, P2312/478 PT02/ENG/ENG

REPORT:

Mr and Mrs Vella of 336 Spinks Road (Lot 10 DP582877) currently have an irrigation main which extends from Hawkesbury River via Wire Lane and Kurmond Road to serves No 720 Kurmond Road, (Lot 101 DP633202) Freemans Reach. The applicant wishes to extend this main from the intersection of Wire Lane and Kurmond Road via Spinks Road to also serve No 366 Spinks Road, Glossodia.

Permission is currently being sought from the Department of Land and Water Conservation to partly transfer approximately 3ha of the current license from 720 Kurmond Road to 366 Spinks Road.

RECOMMENDATION:

The application by Mr and Mrs Vella to extend their existing irrigation be approved.
