ITEM: 13 **The Sydney 2000 Games - Community Torchbearers****FILE NUMBER:** GR030/056Pt03/GMA/OGH24LAX.G08

REPORT:

The Sydney Organising Committee for the Olympic Games has written requesting the support and commitment from every Council in Australia to the Community Torchbearer process. To date, 105 Councils across Australia have been selected to host Judging Panels.

Council has now been invited to provide a representative to be a Local Government Area Judging Panel member for the Community Torchbearer selection process. The commitment of the judge will be:

- Attend Judging Panel 91 at Penrith City Council on the weekend of 27-28 November 1999 between the hours of 8.30 am to 5.30 pm daily.
- All judges are responsible for costs associated with transportation to and from the location and for accommodation for the night of 27 November 1999.
- The number of Nomination Forms for each Judging Panel will not exceed 2,000 and these will be evenly distributed amongst each judge. Each Nomination Form will have in writing, in 100 words or less, why the nominee meets one of the six criteria. The representative will need to have an aptitude for reading through multiple copies of forms and judging the merit of each nomination based on the set criteria.
- A judge is not eligible to be a Community Torchbearer.
- To ensure the judging is fair and equitable, a Judging Panel will consist of a combination of representatives from Local Government, Multicultural and Indigenous Groups and other associated bodies. A chairperson for each Judging Panel will be appointed by the National Australia Day Council.
- The nominated representative for the Judging Panel is entirely at the Council's discretion.

If the Council wishes to nominate a representative, it will need to do so at this meeting and have the form returned immediately.
