HAWKESBURY MUSEUM - OFFER OF GRANT - GG021/212 Pt1

Last Thursday the Premier offered the Council a grant of \$1.15 million (one point one five million dollars) towards the development of a purpose built regional museum in Windsor.

All the conditions of the offer are still being finalised, however, it will include a regional purpose built facility on the land in Baker Street on a dollar for dollar basis.

This is different to the extensions approved by Council that are effectively an addition to the existing premises. While the grant can be used for a building that connects to the existing museum, it will need to be a contemporary building that addresses the streetscape of Baker Street and, I understand, would be the first purpose built regional museum building in the State.

The offer brings to date a total of \$1.45 million (one point four five million dollars) for the Council's museum, library and art gallery project, and staff are still working on seeking further financial assistance.

A regional museum on the site will add to the district's tourist and economic facilities, as well as being an important cultural location.

Should the Council accept the offer then staff would continue to work with the Museum Committee, the engaged architects and consultants, International Conservation Services, to prepare a functional brief and work the project up for final Council approval. My advice is that the earliest the facility could be available would be in the third quarter of 2003, provided the archaeological issue is resolved in the near future.

This is an exciting proposal and I am sure members of the Hawkesbury community would join with the Museum Committee and Councillors in developing and contributing to the display of Hawkesbury's heritage from its earliest indigenous history to today.

I would recommend that Council accept the offer and thank the Government for the opportunity of developing a regional museum in the Hawkesbury.
